The hero of the Noah story is a little bird. For it is this tiny creature of G-d that discovers land for mankind. The Midrash relates an interesting anecdote. This little bird was very concerned and approached G-d with a grievance. "G-d," he said, "You have created massive creatures possessing great weight and sharp claws. These animals are swift and can pounce upon me with little warning. I am a tiny creature and I fear for my life." G-d in His great mercy smiles at this tiny creature and said, "I am going to give you a very special present that will save your life and the lives of your family."
